Sixth Form Message

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This week students were invited to participate in a talk delivered by a guest speaker in the field of Degree Apprenticeships. The classroom was packed and students fully engaged in what was an extremely informative session. Degree apprenticeships are a relatively new concept and there are some misconceptions and confusion around these opportunities. The lunchtime session was a great way to demystify and gain some clarity.

Students learnt the application process takes both determination, planning, refined interview techniques and how you can apply to start straight after Sixth Form - although many student apply at a later stage given the demands of the application process.

Students were introduced to several informative websites and we have collated these in the later part of this bulletin under the heading 'Degree Apprenticeships' to assist. In particular, students looked at the <u>Occupation Maps</u> website where you can establish, in depth, what the skills and qualities are for your occupation of choice and begin to understand what an employer may be looking for within your application; the website is a great starting point when looking at which companies to approach for work experience opportunities, allowing students to increasing the likelihood of their degree apprenticeship application being considered.

Students were also introduced to the <u>STAR</u> method. You can use the STAR method to structure the examples you give to questions, especially in interviews. A job description lists the skills and qualities the employer is looking for and you can use the STAR method to show how you meet these.

We were very pleased that <u>Unifrog</u>, our school preferred platform, is a brilliant tool for finding great apprenticeships; we fully encourage students to complete the Unifrog apprenticeship questionnaire which filters and directs students to the most appropriate degree apprenticeship opportunities for them, sending alerts as companies begin to advertise for their positions.
