This week we have launched a support system which looks at identify students who would benefit from targeted intervention. Students will meet with Mrs Schumann or me and have been tasked with obtaining a list of intervention work from their subject leads. This information is recorded on a sheet, which once returned will be shared with parents so we can work together to support the students.

Year 13s have started to apply to universities through UCAS and have been excited to see the offers rolling in, as well as interviews with Cambridge University. Students should aim to complete their applications by the end of November and staff are always on hand to support with personal statements.

Year 12's have been keen to start making connections and networking ready for their work experience next year. The date of their work experience will be 30th June to 4th July 2025. Please do encourage your child to think about what they may like to do and what company they plan to approach. Placements go quickly and we would like our students to get the best opportunities and not miss out. When students have secured a placement, this will be logged on their Unifrog accounts. We will send more information about how to do this next week.

Students took part in the Young Citizens UK National Bar Mock Trial competition in London over the weekend, where they tried two cases. They were competing before experienced judges, gaining valuable knowledge about the law and barrister skills. Our students were excellent ambassadors and looked very professional.
